Job Title: LCC Regional Setting Team Leader
Reporting to: Regional Route Setting Manager/Regional Deputy Setting Manager

Main Purpose

Working across all LCC walls with other route-setters including freelancers, other regional setters, site-specific setters and trainees to make creative and interesting blocs that are consistent within each location. These blocs must meet the needs and requirements of our customers and centres. Additionally, you will be responsible for the set and in charge of other setters on the day, adhering to the safety procedures and guidelines in place. Other tasks may include stripping and washing of routes at different sites although these are not often. This position is ideal for freelance setters looking for regular setting work, aiming to set two days a week. This work is flexible and some weeks you may also have one set one week and three sets the next. If preferred, one fixed day at one of our walls is optional with the other spread across our other sites.

Your contract will be a minimum of 16h/week or 70h/month.

Main Duties & Responsibilities

- Setting, testing, checking and tweaking of routes and giving constructive feedback. • Potential stripping, washing and maintenance of climbing holds and equipment.
- Provide a high standard of route setting and consistency across all sites.
- Ensuring a progressive grade spread across each area in a variety of styles
- Problem solving during the setting day.
- Managing the setters on the day.
- Meeting the bloc quota for the set area.
- Assisting in training and mentoring of our Regional Setting Team Apprentices (RSTAs). This also includes adding feedback to their Trello accounts to aid their learning & supporting them in their growth as setters.

- Writing handovers of each set, reporting any issues on the day, positive and constructive feedback for the team as well as reporting anything that may be needed at that site.
- Liaising with the Regional Route Setting Manager/Regional Deputy Setting Manager and Centre Managers to ensure close co-ordination of route setting with daily operations.
- Supervision and adherence to all Route Setting Health and Safety Procedures and Policies.
- Act as a Brand Ambassador for the Lakeland Climbing Centre.
- Adding blocs onto our Griptonite database
